### **QUALIFICATION OVERVIEW**

On completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Apply knowledge of WHS legislation in the workplace
- Participate in hazard identification, risk assessment and risk control
- Participate in WHS communication, consultation and issue resolution
- Identify, prevent and report potential workplace emergency situations
- Assist with responding to incidents, and write simple documents
- Organise workplace information, work effectively with diversity
- Communicate in the workplace



### **JOB SUMMARY**

This traineeship reflects the role of skilled operators who apply a broad range of competencies in varied work contexts, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge. They may provide technical advice and support to a team. This qualification is for people who take on WHS responsibilities in addition to their main role. There is an extensive demand for Work Health and Safety (WHS) professionals in both the private and public sectors. Almost all industries are required by legislation to have a WHS professional on their team, which means opportunities for you to move forward in your career.

Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:

- Health and Safety Assistant
- Health and Safety Committee Member
- Health and Safety Representative.

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TRAINEESHIPS**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

You must already have an employer willing to take you on as a trainee to enrol in this programme. Talk to your employer about choosing First Choice College as your Supervising Registered Training Organisation (SRTO) or give us a call on (07) 5689 5060 and we would be happy to talk to your employer.

#### **COST**

Traineeships are funded by the Queensland Government under the User Choice Skills Assure supplier 2020-21 policy. User Choice provides a public funding contribution towards the cost of training and assessment services for eligible Queensland Apprentices and Trainees.

Eligible trainees that meet the Queensland state funding requirements will be charged a set fee per nominal hour. These fees are calculated at a regulated rate of \$1.60 per nominal hour.

Nominal hours will vary depending on electives chosen, however there will be approximately 300 – 400 nominal hours in most cases. Concession rates of 40% (\$0.64 per nominal hour) apply for students who hold a current Health Care Card or who identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander. For eligible school based trainees, the training is fee free.

Non-funded trainees will be charged a fee for service cost. This will be confirmed prior to the commencement of training.

Information regarding costs will be outlined on the agreed training plan, which will be provided to the employer and trainee at time of induction.
